Island changes

RUPA has been and is concerned about Island changes and development. Some recent changes and potential changes have been quite positive. The roundabouts have added a distinct character to The Island in addition to facilitating traffic. The intersection of Frederica Road and Kings Way would also be an easy and natural roundabout after the completion of the one at Demere and Sea Island Road. The completion of the bike trail to the Hampton marina would add to the 'laid-back' character of The Island and add tourist interest while adding a safe outlet for locals exercising and exploring The Island from one end to the other.

FOUR RUPA CONCERNS

1. The board in this new year has noted that RUPA needs to monitor proposed zoning changes on the Island. While many zoning change requests are quite reasonable, sometimes requests are made in error or without considering the impact on the Island environment.
2. The board will also update members on the progress of the Village Plan.
3. Additionally, all the PUBLIC BEACH ACCESS points on St. Simons have been checked. Most are open and accessible. Some have limited encroachment and need signage. Olive Way is under construction. RUPA will continue to watch and inform membership and county enforcement (if necessary) on the status of Island beach access.
4. RUPA has been participating in Adopt-a-Highway quarterly and is working with community organizations to protect the Island environment
